- How was your stay?
- Was everything satisfactory?
- We have a few complaints.
- We really enjoyed our stay.
- Thank you for your honesty. I assure you we will be working on that complain.
- How will you be paying for this?

- I'll pay by cash. / I'll pay by credit card.
- I'll just need your room keys, please.
- Enjoy the rest of your holiday.
- Have a safe trip home.

Conversation
