- Problems you want to raise: I can't open the window in my room. It seems to be stuck. / Air conditioner is noisy. / Carpet smells like cat/dog. / Cockroaches inside the room. / Dirty hotel. / Hotel room attendant does not include clean below the bed. / Noise from neighbors in the hotel. / Toilet leaking noise. / WIFI isn't available in all locations in the hotel. /
- I'll get someone to take a look at it. / I'll have someone to check on it.
