A. Take を使った基本的な対話を繰り返し、口からスムーズ英語が出てくるよう練習しましょう。読むだけでは身につけません。ゆっくり読んでも構わないので、文法と意味を理解しながら読みましょう。

A : Where are you taking me?  
B : I'm taking you to the mobile blood donation center.  
A : Are we donating blood? That's very nice idea.

A : Do you usually take some medicine?  
B : Yes, I usually take some pain killers twice a week.  
A : I got it. Thanks.

B : You should take this medicine 30minutes before each meal.  
A : Okay. Thank you. Is it okay to take this medicine after each meal?  
B : No. I can't recommend doing it. Don't forget to take those medicines.

A : Take your time.  
B : Thanks. Actually I'm busy now.  
A : No problem. Don't be in a hurry.

B : I will take your pulse. (pulse=脈)  
A : Yes, sure.  
B : Thank you.

A : The blood takes oxygen from the lungs.  
B : Yes, the exchange of oxygen takes place in the alveoli.  
(take place=行われる)(alveoli=肺胞)

## How to use take/bring

A : Take this needle and throw it into the pail box.

B : Okay.

A : It's very dangerous.

B : How long does it take for blood donation?

A : It will take 40 minutes.

B : Oh very short. I will take it.

A : Where is Shinjuku clinic in this building?

B : It's on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor. You can take the elevator there.

A : Thank you very much.

B : This picture was taken last summer vacation.

A : It is really beautiful. Where was this taken?

B : Near the Fuji Mountain.

B : I want to order veggie salad and fries please.

A : Is it for dine-in or take-out?

B : Take-out please. Thanks

A : Do you want to take part of the activity?

B : What is the activity about?

A : It is about tree planting in a nearby farm.

A : If you want to proceed, please take the first step.

B : Okay, I am now reading the instruction.

A : Keep it up. Just tell me when you are done.

A : I took up the nursing course because of my mom.

B : I see. How was the nursing course?

A : At first, I didn't like it but now I love it.

A : Please take your belongings with you.

B : Is it not safe to leave my things here? Does somebody steal?

A : It's not safe to leave your belongings here. They might be stolen.

B : Please be careful who you trust.

A : Why? That sounds very serious.

B : Yes it is. A lot of people nowadays will take advantage.

## How to use take/bring

B : I hope you listened very carefully to your mom's advice.  
A : Should I take it or leave it?  
B : The decision is yours.

A : Did you take down notes?  
B : Notes about what teacher?  
A : About the important points of how to screen the blood.

A : Please take extra care of your health.  
B : Yes, I am more watchful this time. I usually visit the clinic twice a week.  
A : That sounds great.

A : How do you feel?  
B : I get dizzy when I stand up.  
A : Do not stand up quickly. Take a rest for at least 15 minutes. I will get something for you to drink. I hope you would feel better soon.

A : How long does it take for blood donation?  
B : It depends on the person. But mostly it takes 20 minutes for the full blood donation.  
After that, you must take a rest for at least 10 minutes.

B : I've just got here.  
A : You're late for 20 minutes.  
B : I'm sorry. The train was delayed because of heavy snow.

A : Where did you get your new white coat?  
B : I got this from an online store.  
A : Can you tell me the name of that site?

B : I get a little weak.  
A : Are you all right? I will get you something to drink.  
A : Thank you. Please bring something cold to drink.

B : I'm getting tired.  
A : Why do you say that?  
B : Because we have treated many donors.

## How to use take/bring

- A : How did you get a reward from the head office?  
B : I'm not sure.  
A : I think you are so kind for your patients.

A : The book about how to do blood screening? Or is it the English textbook?  
B : Please bring both. Thank you!

- A : Can you bring me a bouquet of flowers?  
B : Why? What's the occasion?  
A : Nothing really. I just want to place it in my flower vase.

- A : I am going to bring the laboratory results to your room.  
B : I see. Thanks.  
A : You're welcome.

- A : The birthday cake will be brought by Janice.  
B : Amazing! My birthday will be very special.  
A : Yes it is. Hope you will enjoy your day.

- A : If he brings John, I will leave.  
B : But why? Do you hate John that much?  
A : Not really. I am just uncomfortable having his around.

- A : I am going to bring my guitar to the party.  
B : Are you going to sing with your guitar?  
A : No. It's Candice who will sing. I will just play the guitar for her.

A : Please bring back the form when you're done filling it out.  
B : Yes, I will. When you're finished, I will give you another form for your personal information.

A : The blood test results will be brought by the technologist in a moment.  
B : I'm not sure if it turns out normal.  
A : Don't worry, we will know it soon.

B : A number of books have already been brought back to the library.  
A : What? I'm still reading those books.  
B : You have to return those on time.

A : She has been bringing her friends along in the church for years.  
B : I think she is a nice person.  
A : I also have the same impression. I will try to invite my friends to the church.
