- What sizes do you have? / What are the cars available? / What are my options?
- We have (types of cars: mini, light, compact, mid - size, full - size, luxury, SUV and van).
- How much is the (type of car)?

- How many car seats does a (type of car) have? / How many can fit in a (type of car)? / How many can seat in a (type of car)?
- I'll take a (type of car you've chosen). / I'll have a (type of car you've chosen).
- How long will you be renting the car?
- Just for (days you wanted to use the car).
- How many people will be driving the car? / How many will be using the car?
- Would you like insurance?
- It is (payment for insurance) a day and it covers everything regardless of fault.
- Can I see your driver's license and a credit card?
- Would you like me to charge it on this card? / Will you pay it by cash or credit card?

## **Conversation**

S - A - N - A - E.

A : Your address please?

B : I am from Japan. Would you like my address in Japan?

A : Just the city name.

B : Kawasaki City, Japan.

A : Can I see your driver's license and a credit card?

B : Sure. Here it is.

A : Great. That will be \$330. Would you like me to charge it on this card?

B : Yes. That will be fine.

A : Please sign here. You can pick up your car downstairs. Your expected time to return the car is on 4<sup>th</sup> of May. That is exactly five days. Show the attendant this invoice. When you return the car, bring this invoice with you. Also, the gas tank is full, you should fill up the gas tank before you return. If you don't want to, we can do it for \$10 a gallon.
