Nurse: I'd like you to keep the oxygen on for another thirty minutes then I'll check your levels again. I'll take the probe off your finger now and check in on you later.

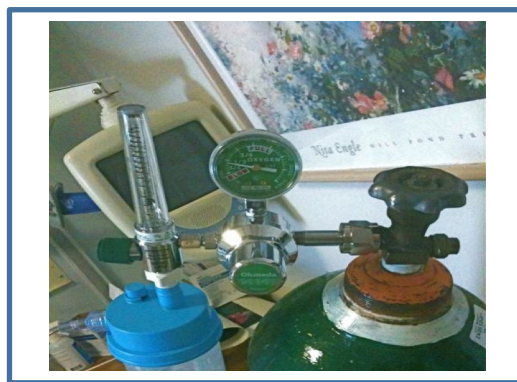
Patient: Alright. Thanks, Nurse.
