## Transportation

### Useful Phrases:

- Does this (mode of transportation: train, taxi, bus) go to (place you wanted to go)?
- Where is the (ticketing counter / place to buy the ticket / toilet / baggage claim area)?
- How much is a (ticket / round – trip / one – way ticket / first – class ticket) to (place you wanted to go)?
- Where can I (catch a cab / buy a ticket / put my suit case)?
- A (ticket / round – trip ticket / one – way ticket / first – class ticket) to (place you wanted to go), please?
- How long is the (flight / bus ride / train ride)?
- When does the (airplane / train / bus / ferry / boat) leave?

- When do we (arrive in / get to / depart from / leave from) (name of place)?

## **Conversation**

*Instruction: Read the dialogue carefully twice. First reading: Waiter – teacher, A – student. Second reading: Waiter – student, A – teacher.*

A : Excuse me. Does this bus go downtown?

B : Yes ma'am.

A : Thank you very much.

B : You're welcome.

A : Excuse me Sir. Do you know where the ticketing counter is?

B : Yes. It is just behind the baggage claim area.

A : Thank you very much.

B : You're welcome.

Ticketing Officer : Good evening!

A : How much is a round – trip ticket to Paris?

Ticketing Officer : It is €553 ma'am.

A : A round – trip ticket to Paris, please?

A : Excuse me. How long is the train ride to Kuala Lumpur from Singapore?

B : About six to seven hours.

A : Do you know when the last train will leave?  
B : I don't know.  
A : It's okay. Thank you very much.  
B : You're welcome.
